Point Cook is one of world's first military airfields and is now the oldest, continuously operating, airfield in the world. It is part of RAAF Base Williams and throughout its long history has catered for military flying training. When this was relocated in the mid 1990s the airfield was opened to civil operations and identified as being surplus to Defence of Defence requirements. AOS has managed the airfield since 1997 during which time Defence has sought to finalise its disposal.

Scope:

- Provide a 7 day a week, 365 day a year presence;
- Conduct daily serviceability inspections;
- Schedule and oversight maintenance activities;
- Liaise with airport users on airport access, charging and leasing;
- Make recommendations to Defence on applications to conduct non-aviation related activity; and
- Develop and maintain emergency procedures.
